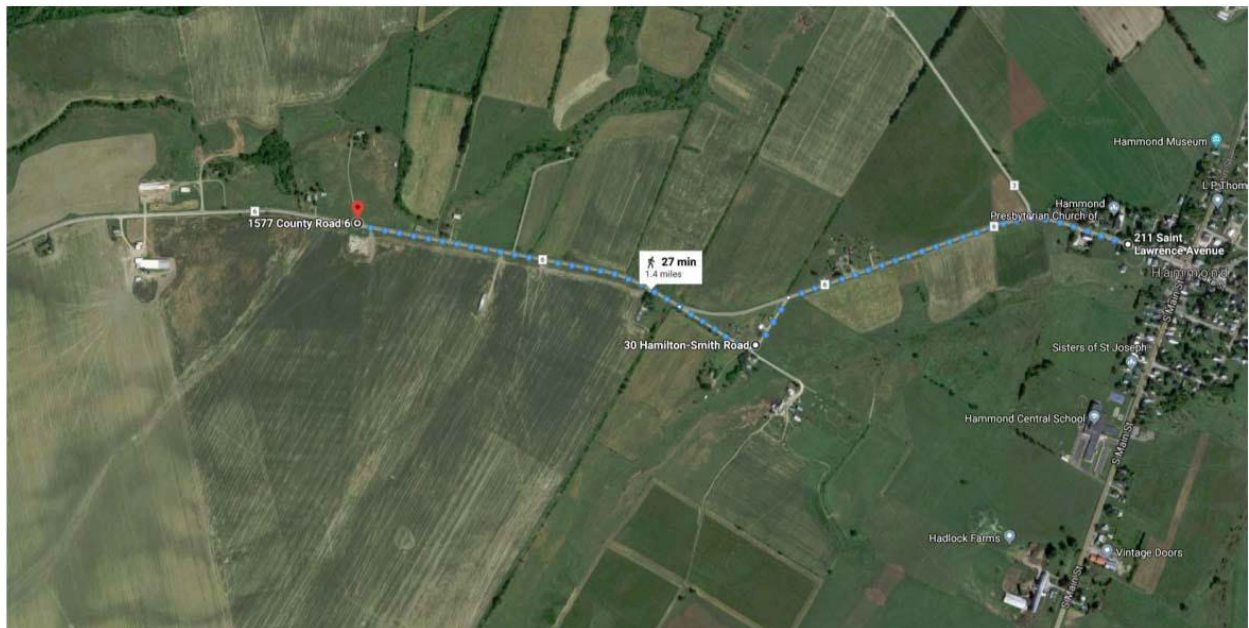

— 5K Kilt Run/Walk Details —

FOR: Adults and ALL Kids who like to run!

Line-up starts at Hammond Central School. Bagpipers will lead the procession of 5K Kilt runners/walkers from school to the starting point on St. Lawrence Avenue. The course is of varied terrain, with a true starting point in front of Hammond's historic stone Presbyterian Church. Runners/walkers will head toward Chippewa Bay through beautiful farm land with 3 stone houses made by the early Scottish settlers. While mostly along Hammond's Chippewa Bay Road (Country Route 6), there are a few twists and turns along the way. At approximately 1.3 miles, a right hander sends participants uphill to a scenic loop with a view of a pond, before returning to town.
